Wood + Body: Expressions of Contemporary Jewelry

Curator: Jennifer-Navva Milliken July 2 - November 7, 2021

Philadelphia PA: The Center for Art in Wood is pleased to present Wood + Body, an exhibition of contemporary jewelry by leading and emerging artists who have dedicated their practices to exploring the relationship between the dynamic, sensual material of wood and the mobile, fleshly human body. Both wood and the body are rife with narratives and conceptual significance, rooted in ancient art and literature but continuing to influence the present. In the surprising but eminently wearable works on view in the exhibition, wood replaces the gemstone and beckons for a new way of valuing the "jewel," while demonstrating the deep material understanding possessed by these artists, who are as facile in woodworking techniques as they are in metalsmithing. As a group, united by the condition of wearability and the use of wood, these intriguing works represent the wide range of creative approaches that characterizes contemporary jewelry practice.

On view in the exhibition are pieces occupying a range of scales and features of the body—from rings to large-scale neckpieces and brooches. Several works from the Center's permanent collection are included in the presentation.
